Church of God Youth and Discipleship is proud to partner with a new Home for Children in Nogales, Mexico. Join us on this inaugural trip and get involved in what God is doing in Nogales.



Nogales is a border town located just 60 miles south of Tucson, Arizona. Unofficial estimates put the population at 350,000. Many of these residents are children who have been abandoned as their parents endeavor to cross the U.S. border in search of jobs and financial security. Many children are forced to steal just to survive.

On this trip, you will see the amazing progress that has been made through generous YWEA support in 2010.

Over the seven day trip, we will

- tour the new orphanage and meet the children and workers
- participate in a Children's Ministry Leadership Training Event
- minister at various Church of God congregations
- in Nogales and the surrounding areas
- minister and work at the orphanage and in Nogales
- participate in the dedication service of New Life Home for Children

## **Questions and Answers**

What is the primary purpose of the STEP trip to Poza Rica, Mexico? The primary purpose is to minister and work at the Casa Vida Nueva in Nogales.

What does the cost include: airfare, bus transportation, meals, insurance, lodging in hotel (four per room), t-shirt, trip journal

What is not included: bottled water and snacks, tips for bellman and porters (\$1.00 per bag at each hotel and at airport), tips at meals (\$1.00 per meal)

What if I want to meet the group in Tucson and drive, rather than fly? The land package, which includes hotel, ground transportation, meals, insurance, and t-shirt is \$700.00. This also applies to those who want to secure their own flight to Tucson. You just need to plan to arrive about the same time as those flying with the group itinerary.

*Is a passport required?* YES! As of January 1, 2007, all entering Mexico must have a passport! Apply early!

Can I depart from another city other than Atlanta? Yes, at an additional cost

*How many will stay in each room?* The price quoted is the four per room rate. For less than four per room, there will be an additional charge per person

Will there be interpreters? Yes, interpreters will be provided on the trip

What about insurance? Medical insurance is provided. You will need to secure your own trip cancellation insurance, if so desired

What if I sign up and something happens that I can't go? As long as Delta allows, there can be a name change at an additional charge, after ticketing

Will the deposit be counted as a part of the total cost of the trip? Yes, it will be deducted from your total amount due

Will children be permitted on the trip? Children are encouraged to participate with parents or chaperons.
