

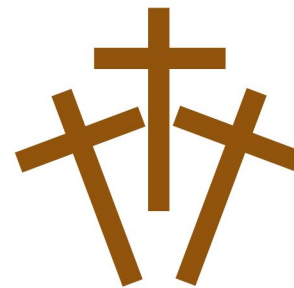

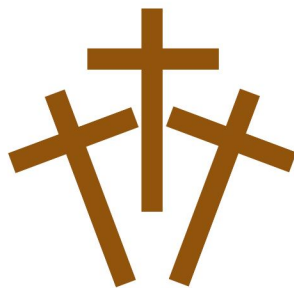

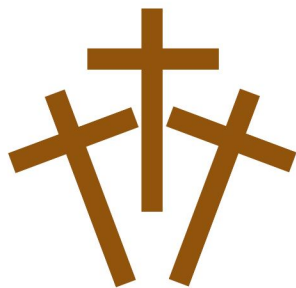

- C) judge me and all that I do.



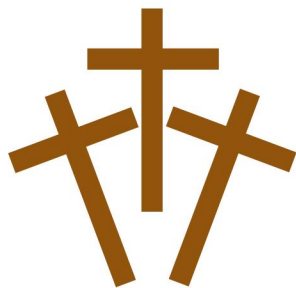

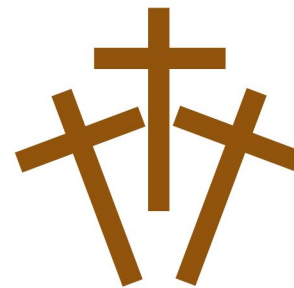

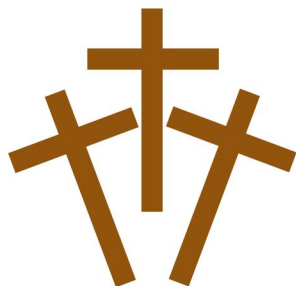
These verses say that man is sinful. But what is sin anyway? Here is a good definition to remember: Sin is anything I think, anything I say or anything I do that displeases God.

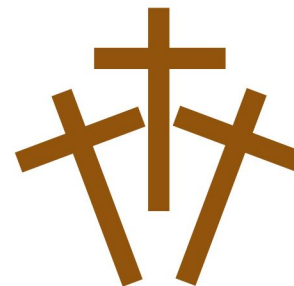

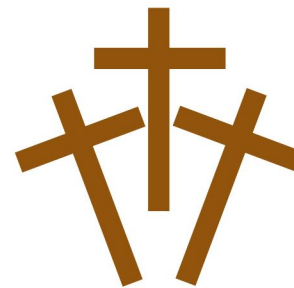
Some people live very long lives. But I bet if you could talk to someone who has lived a hundred or more years, they would still say that their lives have gone by very fast.

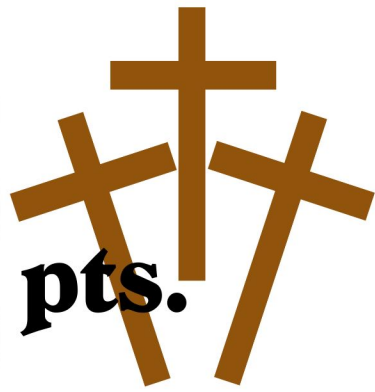
