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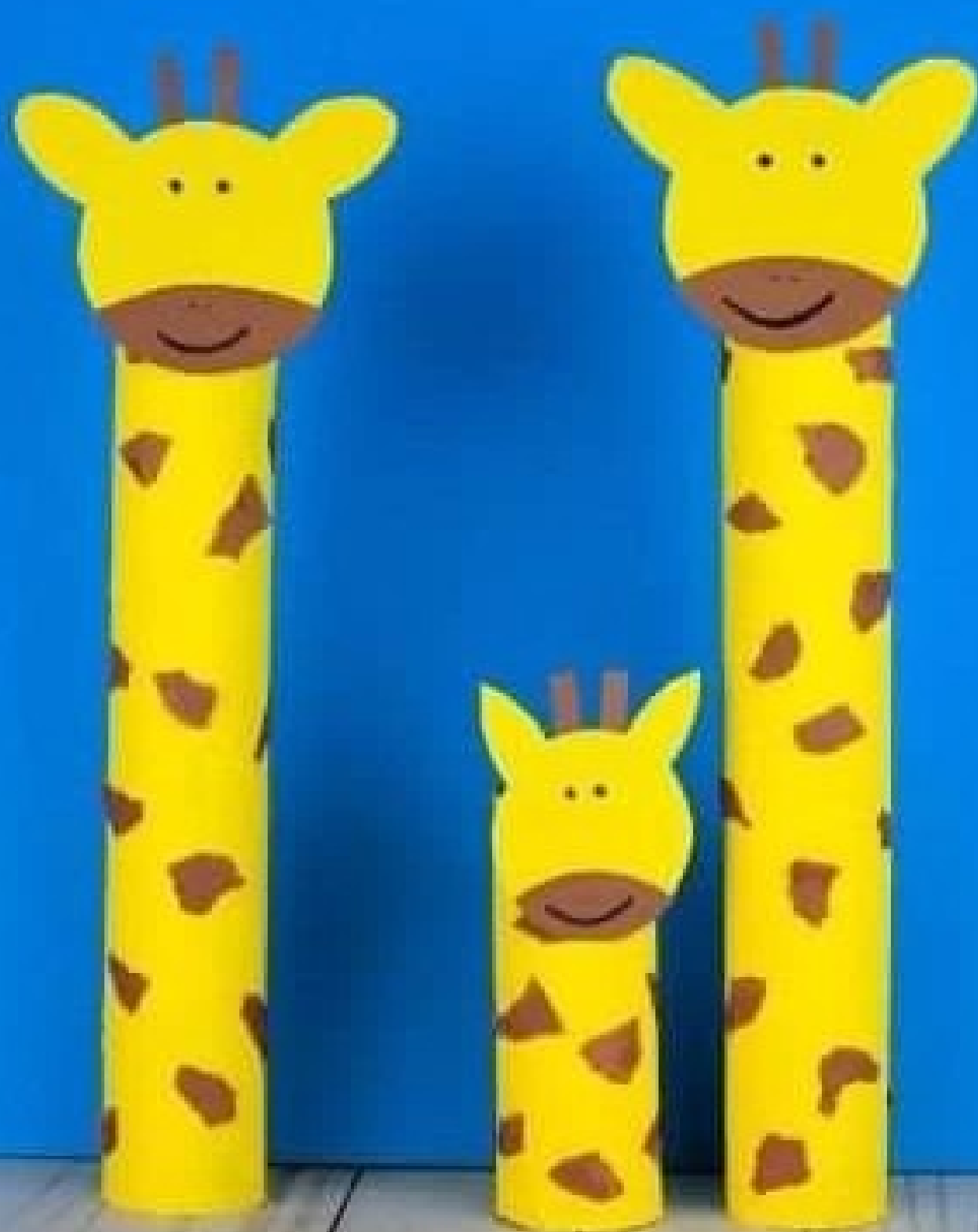

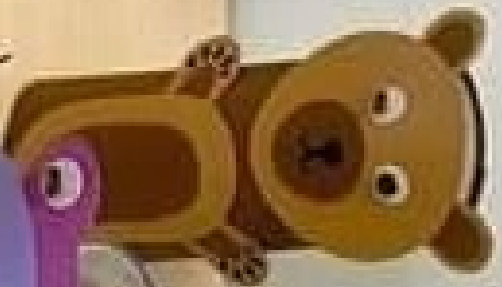




















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Charmin' Robots

Who says robots have to be cold, gray metal? To make one of these bright 'bots, start by painting a toothpick and the inside and outside of a bathroom tissue tube with acrylic paint. Let these dry, then paint the robot's control panel, eyes, and other details. Cut a pipe cleaner in half and coil each piece around a pen. Use a pushpin to poke two holes into the tube, then insert the pipe cleaner arms. Glue a paper circle to one end of the toothpick and glue the other end inside the tube, as shown.

Stick Figures

This open-ended project will stir up tons of creativity. Simply use acrylic paint to decorate a wood paint stir stick with a face and clothing. Add details with stamps and markers and use tacky glue to adhere embellishments, such as pom-poms, buttons, and rickrack. For the hair, use a drill (adults only) with a small bit to make several holes at the top of the stick. Loop and twist lengths of craft wire through the holes. *

CHAPTER'S TIP

* Give your stick figure's hair a perm by curling the wire around a marker (see the stick at far left) or a skewer (third from left), or crimp it into zigzags with needle-nose pliers (far right).

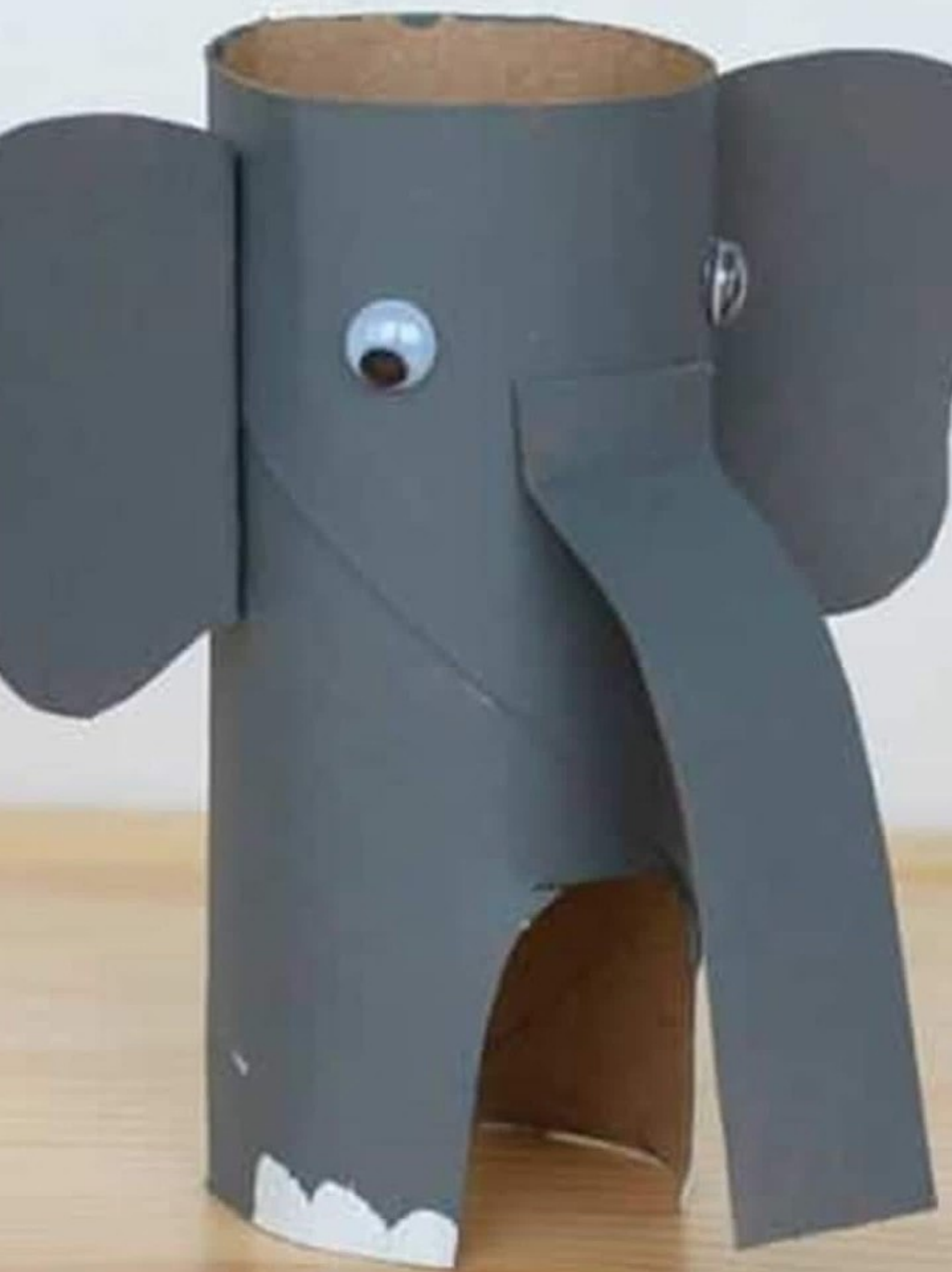

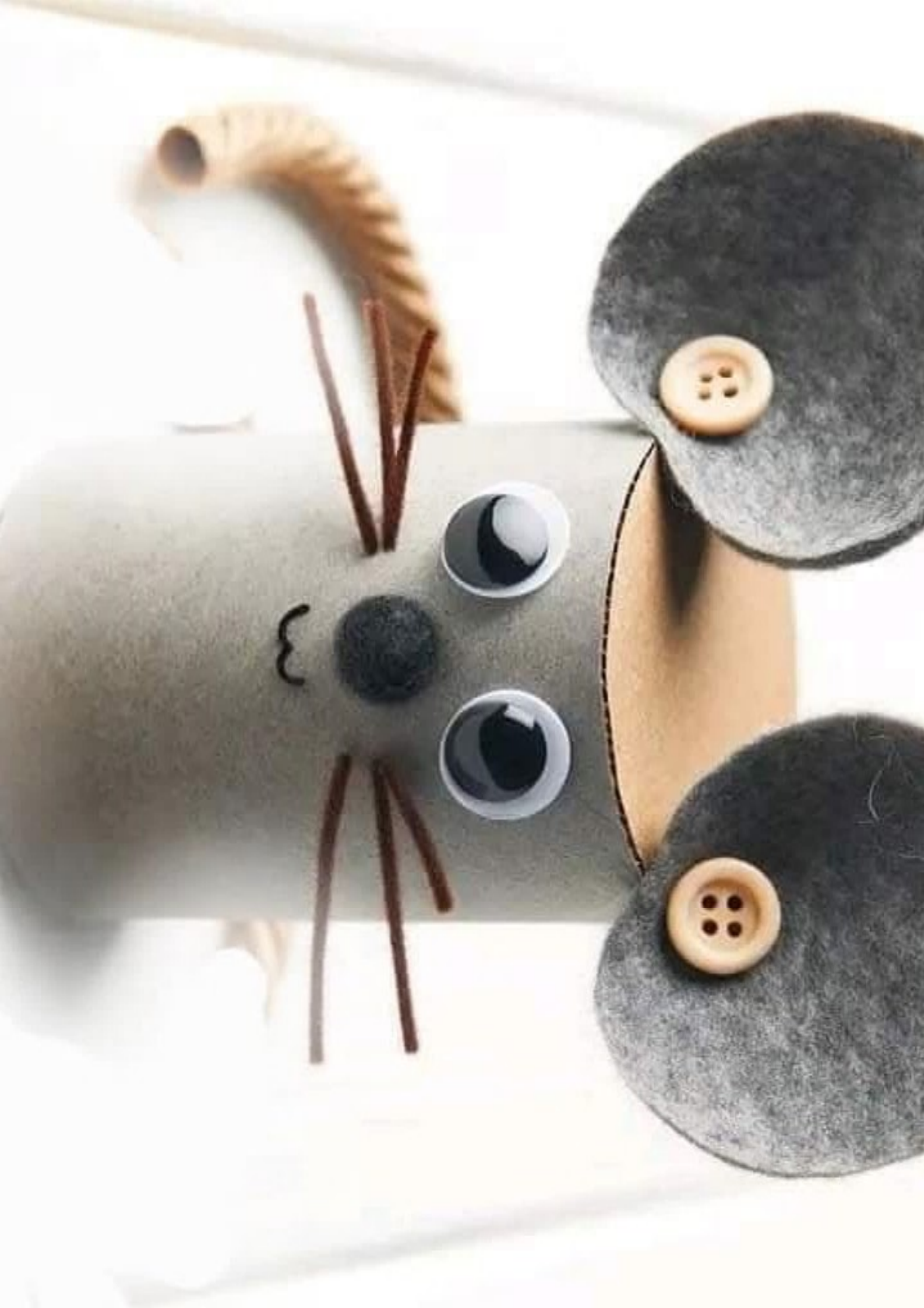




















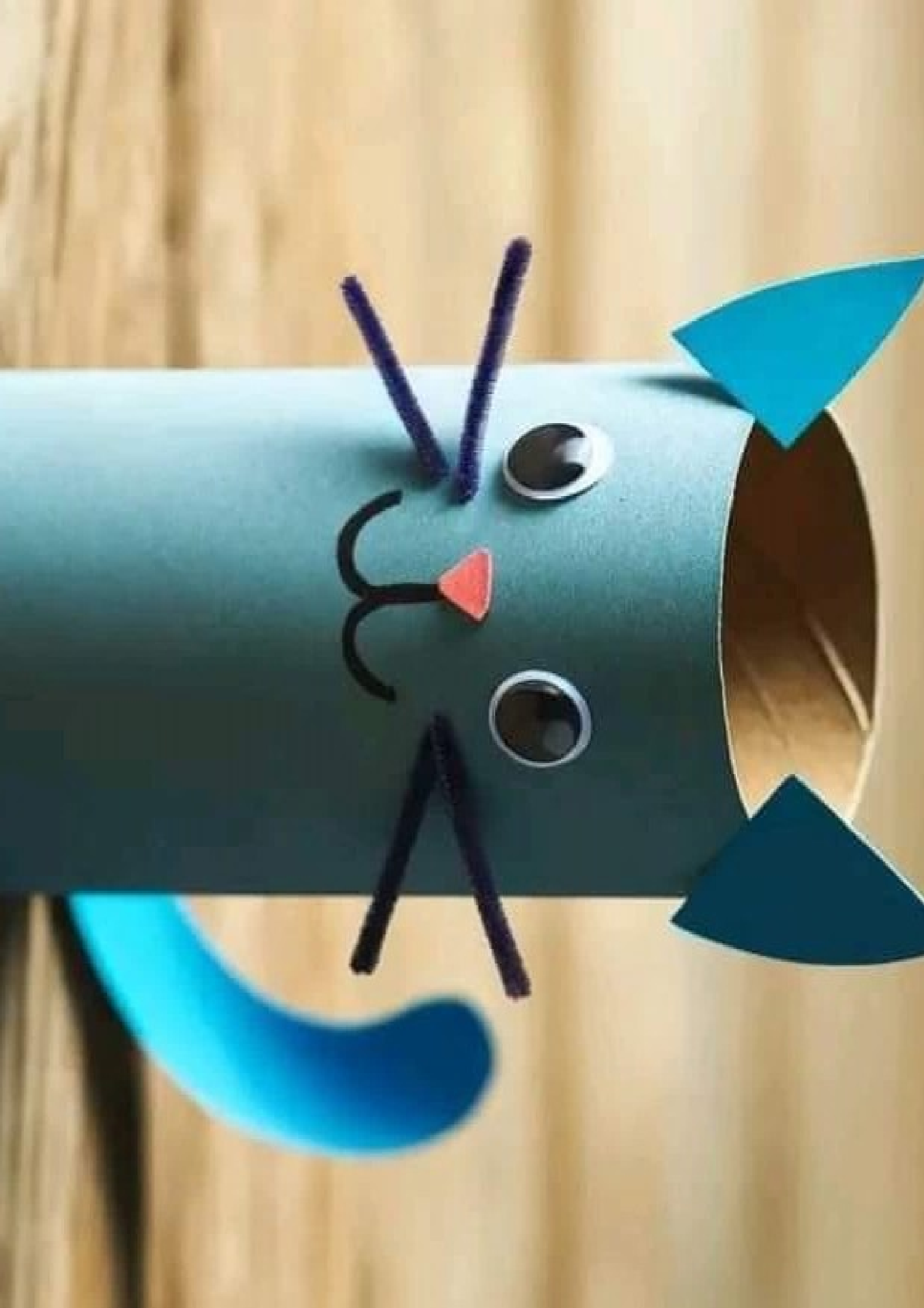
