Pluto

Venus

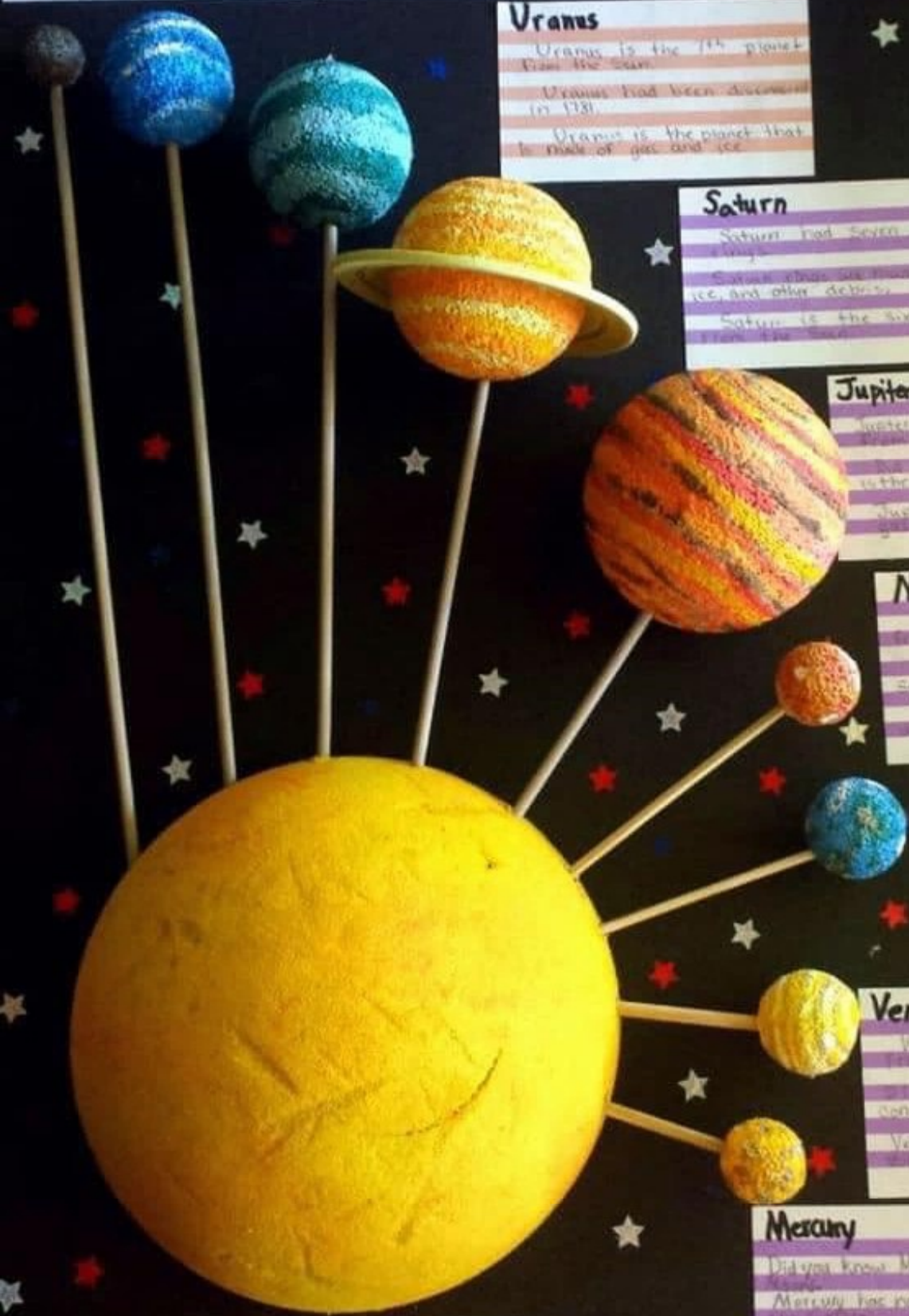
Venus is the 2nd planet from the Sun.

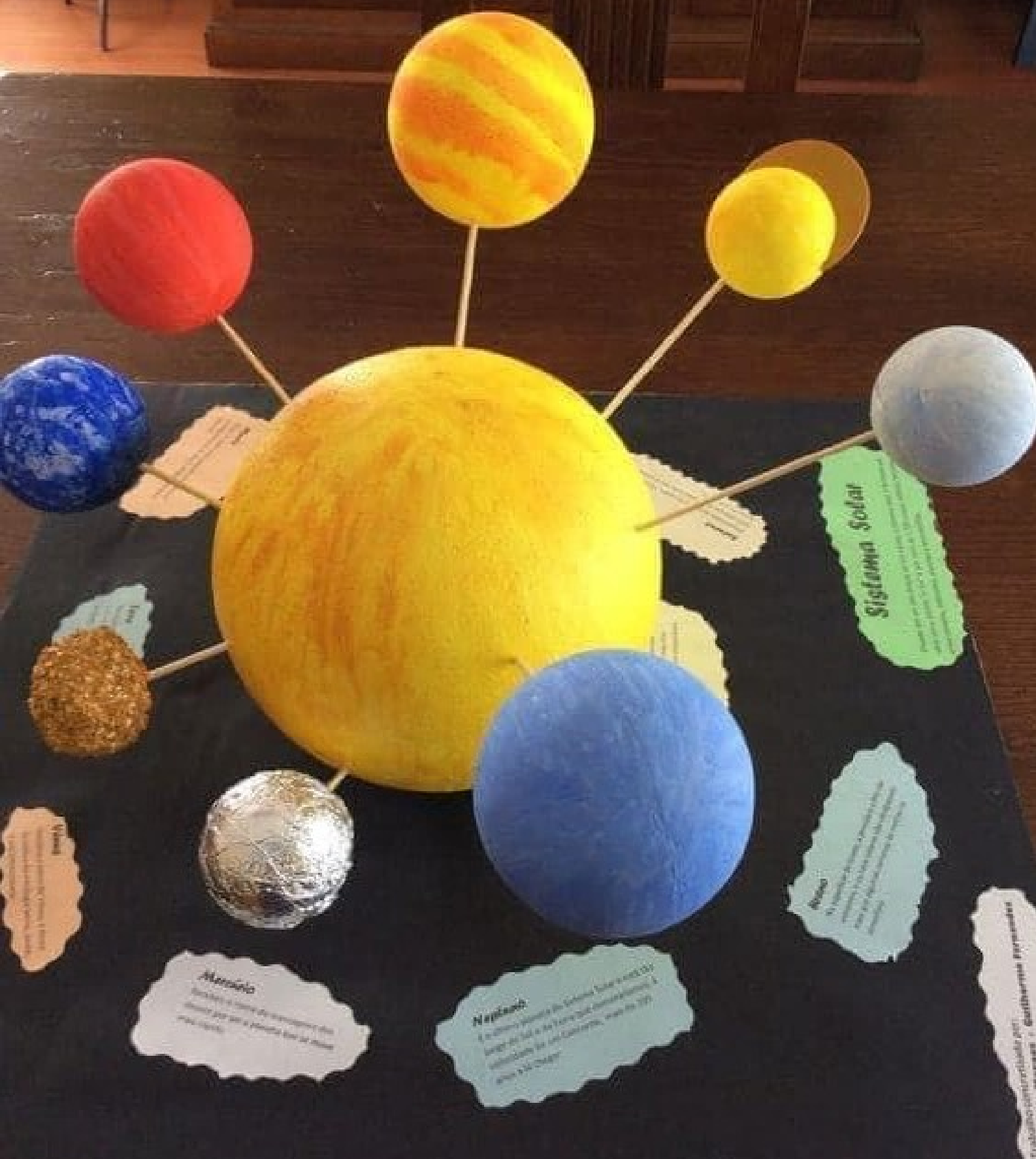

Sistema Solar

Mercurio

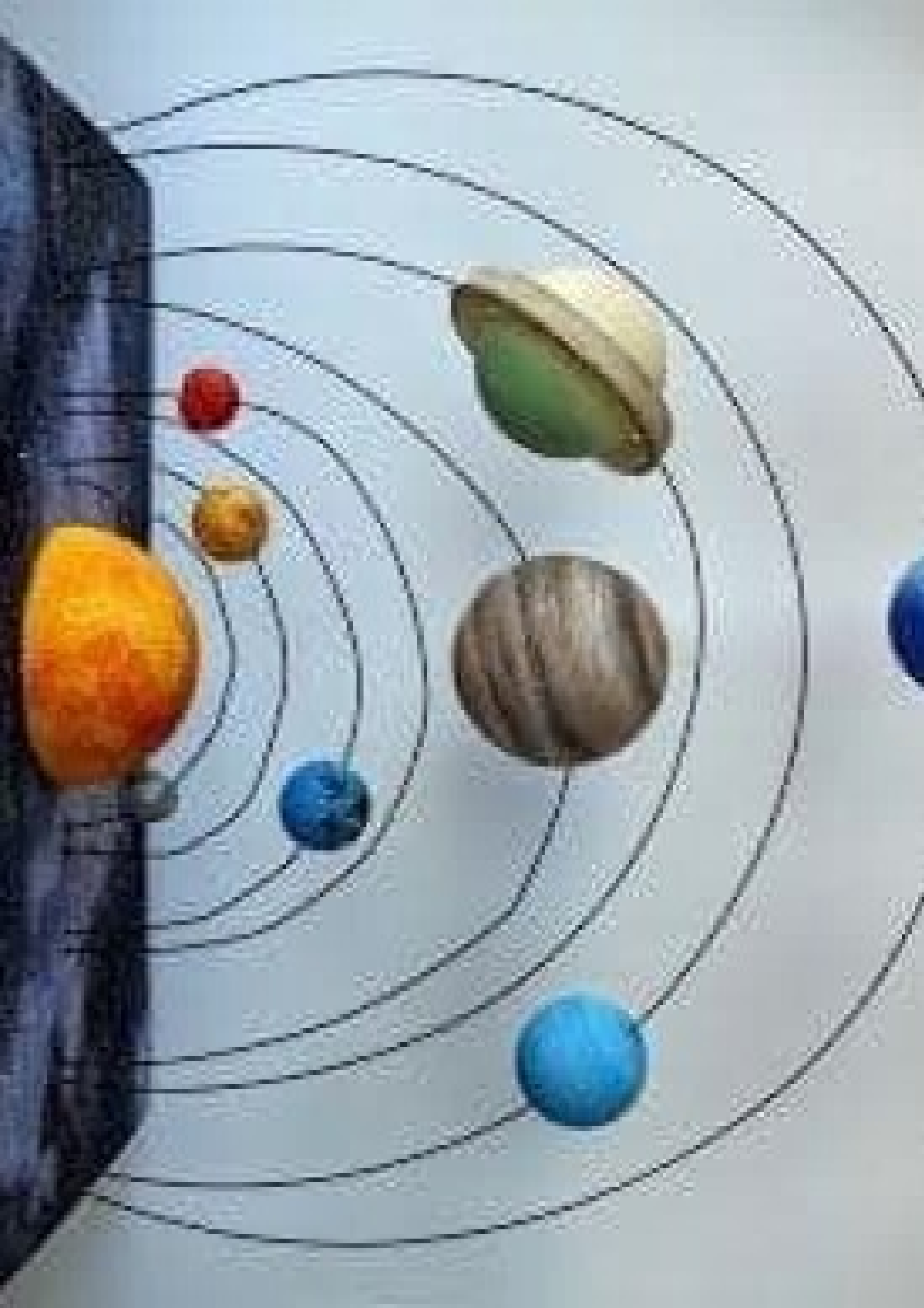
