Important facts about Venus Williams

- Venus was introduced to tennis by her father on the public courts in Los Angeles, California from the early 1990s to Compete.
- She has won eight Grand Slam titles in singles in the Women's Tennis Association (WTA) tennis tournaments.
- She became the World No. 1 for the first time on February 25, 2002, becoming the first African-American woman to achieve this achievement.
- She is known for changing the women's game and bringing a new, aggressive style of power and aggression to the women's professional tennis tour.
- She is often considered as one of the best players ever, player of the generation and also is widely considered as one of the greatest players of century.
- Williams has won nine Olympic gold medals. She has won more Olympic Medals than any other female athlete.



Stevie Wonder

Name: Stevie Ray Wilson-Harvey-Arkins
 Legal Name: Stevland Hardaway Morris
 Stage name: Stevie Wonder
 Born: May 13th, 1950 in Saginaw, Michigan, USA.
 Born prematurely and was blind since shortly after birth (due to congenital opacification of conditions in which the growth of the eyes is impaired and causes the retina to detach). As a child taught himself to play the harmonica, piano and drums before age 10.



1960s:
 1961 - Signed with Motown's Tamla label at the age of 11 as Little Stevie Wonder.
 1962 - Signed Absolu, 1969 - Stevie Wonder had 22 top 100 hits.
 1964 - Unveiled the name "Stevie".
 Recorded classical items, worked to organize his musicotherapy and performing capabilities.

1970s:
 1970s - Wrote music, went through an innovative period of production and produced a massive catalog. During this decade he received 23 Grammy Awards.

1980s:
 1980s - An entrepreneur, but also committed to the unique musical form. Created a television show, which included "I Am Your Father's Son", "He Rides The Wind", a segment instrumental hit of 10 songs, "The Best Way To Acquire Happiness", "A Day In The Life", "I'm Still Standing" and "I'm Still Standing".
 1981 - Launched his own record label, "Geffen".
 1982 - Received a Grammy for "I'm Still Standing".
 1983 - Inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

1990s:
 Continued his artistic and musical experimentation, but in a clearer path, collaborating with other artists and using all the modern and Pandoramic dimensions. He released a new album and other various compilations including the compilation "Ubuntu Anthology" (2006).
 2000 - Received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Recording Academy.
 2000 - Received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Endowment for the Arts.
 2001 - Received a lifetime achievement award by George W. Bush's "President's Medals of Arts and Culture".
 2002 - Presented by Michelle Obama.

2000s:
 Commended for his "outstanding contributions" and honored African-American musicians for their "distinguished artistry". The Hall of Fame induction ceremony took place on April 27, 2003. The ceremony honored the Hall of Fame members, including Stevie Wonder, Earth, Wind & Fire, Prince, Bruce Springsteen, Hall & Oates, and the Bee Gees.
 2005 - Received the Presidential Medal of Freedom.
 2006 - Received a lifetime achievement award from the National Endowment for the Arts.
 2007 - Received a lifetime achievement award by George W. Bush's "President's Medals of Arts and Culture".






1791 Mozart died at the age of 35




