UNDERSTANDING THE STORY:

In the beginning God created (made) everything.

- Do you remember in how many days God created everything?
- Can you name what God created on each day? (1- light, 2 - firmament/sky, 3 - dry land, seas, and plants, 4 - sun, moon, and stars, 5 - animals that fly and animals that swim, 6 - land animals and people, 7 - God rested.)

On day six, after God had made land animals, He did something very special; God created a man.

- What did God form man out of? (Genesis 2:7) How did man become a living person? (Genesis 2:7)

God planted a beautiful garden called Eden.

- What could Adam eat in the garden? What was the name of the tree that God said not to eat from? What would happen if somebody ate from that tree?
- God gave Adam a special job with the animals. What was it? (Genesis 2:19-20)

God created Adam, but there was nobody else like Adam; he was alone.

- God caused Adam to fall asleep and He took one of Adam's ribs, and then closed up his body again. Can you guess what God made that rib into? Now Adam had another person to be with! What was the woman's name?

When God created people, He made them different from everything else in the world.

- Before God created people, what was on the earth? (Animals, plants, water, etc.)
- How are people and animals different from each other? (Animals can eat and sleep and play, but they cannot know God and choose to love God, like people can.)

SIMPLE TRUTHS:

When God created the world and everything in it, He was thinking about us.

- Did God make the earth in the right way so that people could live on it? Did God make air for us to breathe, water for us to drink, and food for us to eat? Did God give us animals to enjoy?
- When God created, He showed us how powerful He is. Did He also show us how loving He is?

When God made everything, all of it was completely perfect and good.

- One day everything will be perfect and good again...in heaven with God. The Bible says that we can't go to heaven unless we have been born again; that means we have to be made alive spiritually...in our hearts. We all have done wrong, and that separates us from God, but God will forgive us if we ask Him to.
- Do you know what Jesus did for us on the cross? Was He being punished for something He did, or for the wrong that we have done? Do you want to ask Jesus to forgive you of your sin, and to make you born again, so that you can one day live with Him in heaven and also enjoy Him right now on earth?

Because God is our Creator we should honor Him with our lives.

- God loves each of us. How can we show our love for God? (By obeying His Word in the Bible. When we do what God says, we are showing Him that we love Him.)
- When we do what Jesus says, will we be blessed? (James 1:25, John 13:17)
- What are some ways that we can get to know God better?






THE CRAFT
