

GENESIS 3:1-24



UNDERSTANDING THE STORY:

When God saw everything that He had created, He said that it was very good.

- Since everything that God made was good, were Adam and Eve perfectly good too?

God placed Adam and Eve in a beautiful garden called Eden.

- What was the one command/rule that God gave to Adam and Eve? (Genesis 2:15-17) What was the name of the tree that God told them not to eat from? What would happen if they ate the fruit from that tree?
- Did God give them that command because He loved them? (Yes, God loved them and wanted them to choose to love and obey Him.)

The devil disguised himself as a serpent and came to Eve in the garden.

- Who is the devil/Satan? Do you know what the Bible says about Satan? (He is a liar - John 8:44; he came to steal, kill, and destroy - John 10:10)
- The serpent told Eve that if she ate the fruit she would not die. But, what did God say would happen if she ate the fruit?
- Was the devil/serpent trying to make Eve believe that God was not perfectly good to her?

Eve saw that the fruit was good for food, that it was pleasant to look at, and a tree to make her wise...

- Did Eve eat the fruit? Did she obey God or the devil?

When Adam and Eve ate the fruit, they knew they had done wrong.

- When they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden, how did they feel? Had they ever been afraid of God before? Were Adam and Eve perfect any longer?
- When God called to them, what did He say? Did Adam and Eve make excuses for their sin?

God sent Adam and Eve out of the Garden of Eden because they had sinned.

- If Adam and Eve ate the fruit from the Tree of Life, which was in the garden, they would live forever. Would it be good for them to live forever and ever, with sin in their hearts?

SIMPLE TRUTHS:

When we see how things are today, we know that there is sin and badness in the world.

- Why is sin bad? (Sin separates us/takes us away from God, because God is perfect and holy.)
- Does God love people? What has God done so that we could be forgiven of our sin?

The devil told Eve a terrible lie.

- Does the devil want us to believe his lies? Does the devil want to help us or to hurt us?
- What does Jesus want to do for us? (He wants to forgive us, He wants to give us eternal life, and He wants to have a relationship with us. He loves us so much.)

God wants to save us from the power of sin and give us eternal life.

- Can we ask Jesus to forgive us? Does anyone want to do that now?
- If Jesus has forgiven us, can we talk to God at any time? What are some ways that we can get to know God better?







1. After making your copies, use scissors to cut out the necessary amount of Eve figures needed for your class.




DURING CLASS INSTRUCTIONS:
