

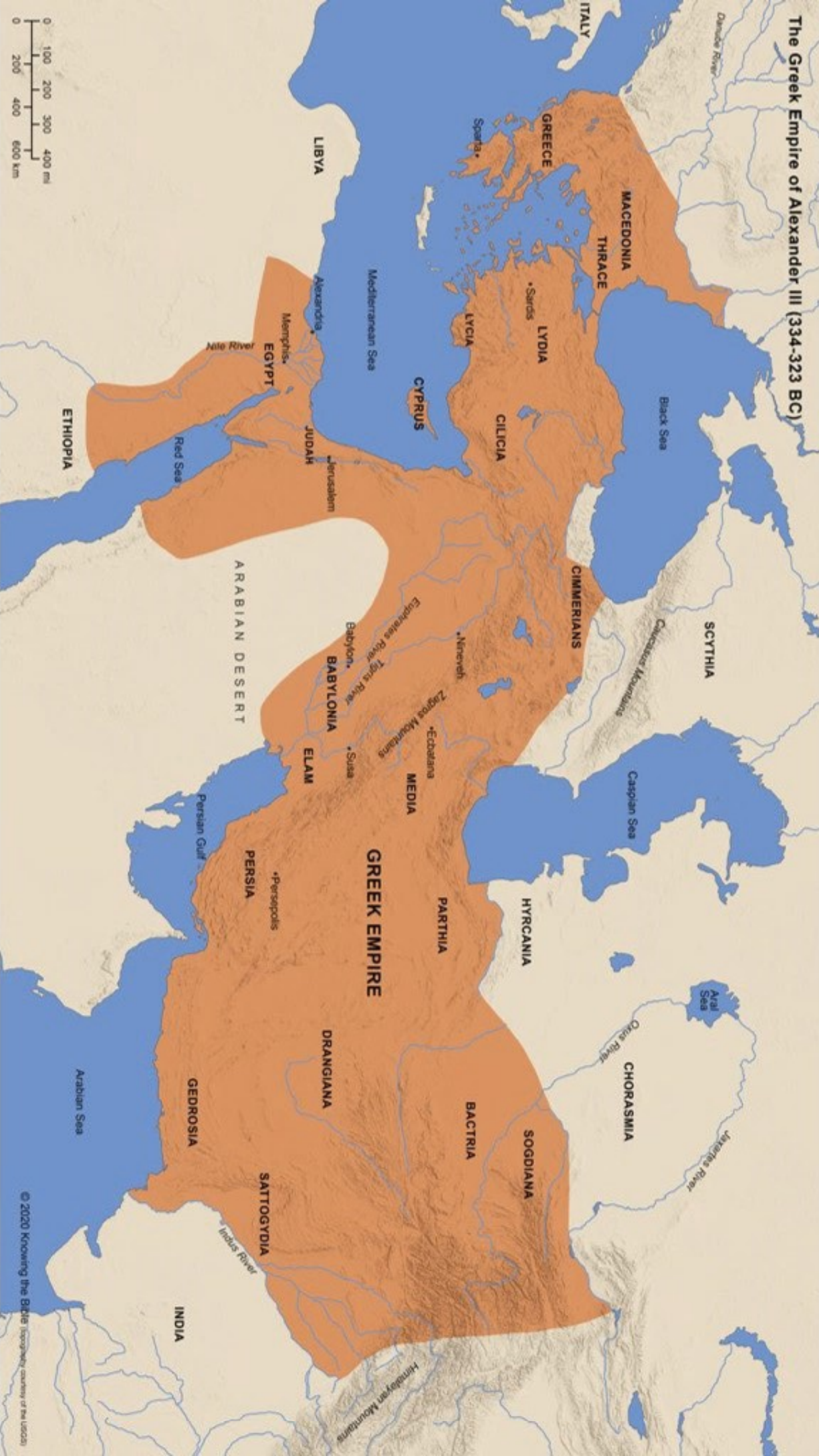

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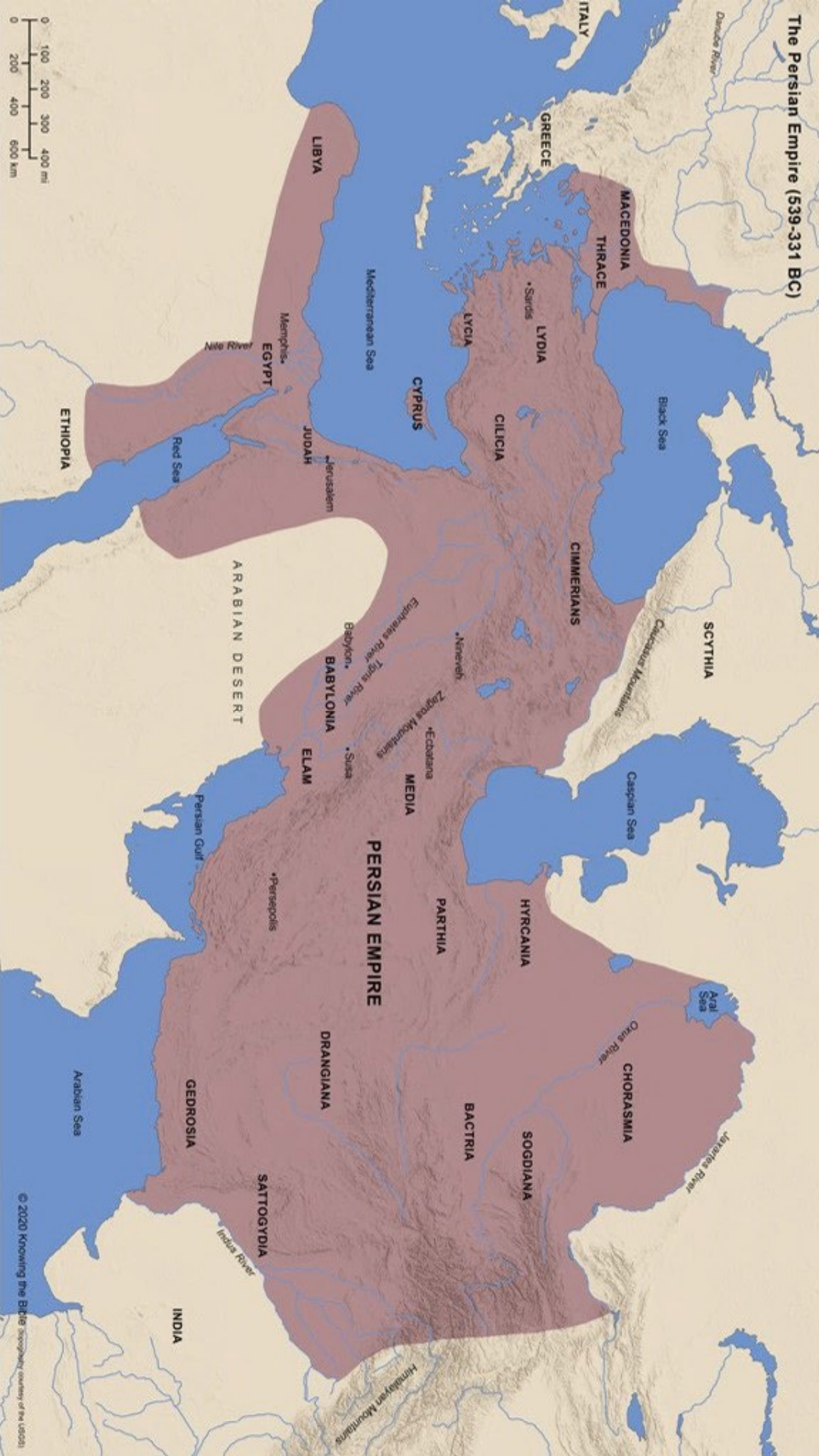
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The Greek Empire of Alexander III (334-323 BC)

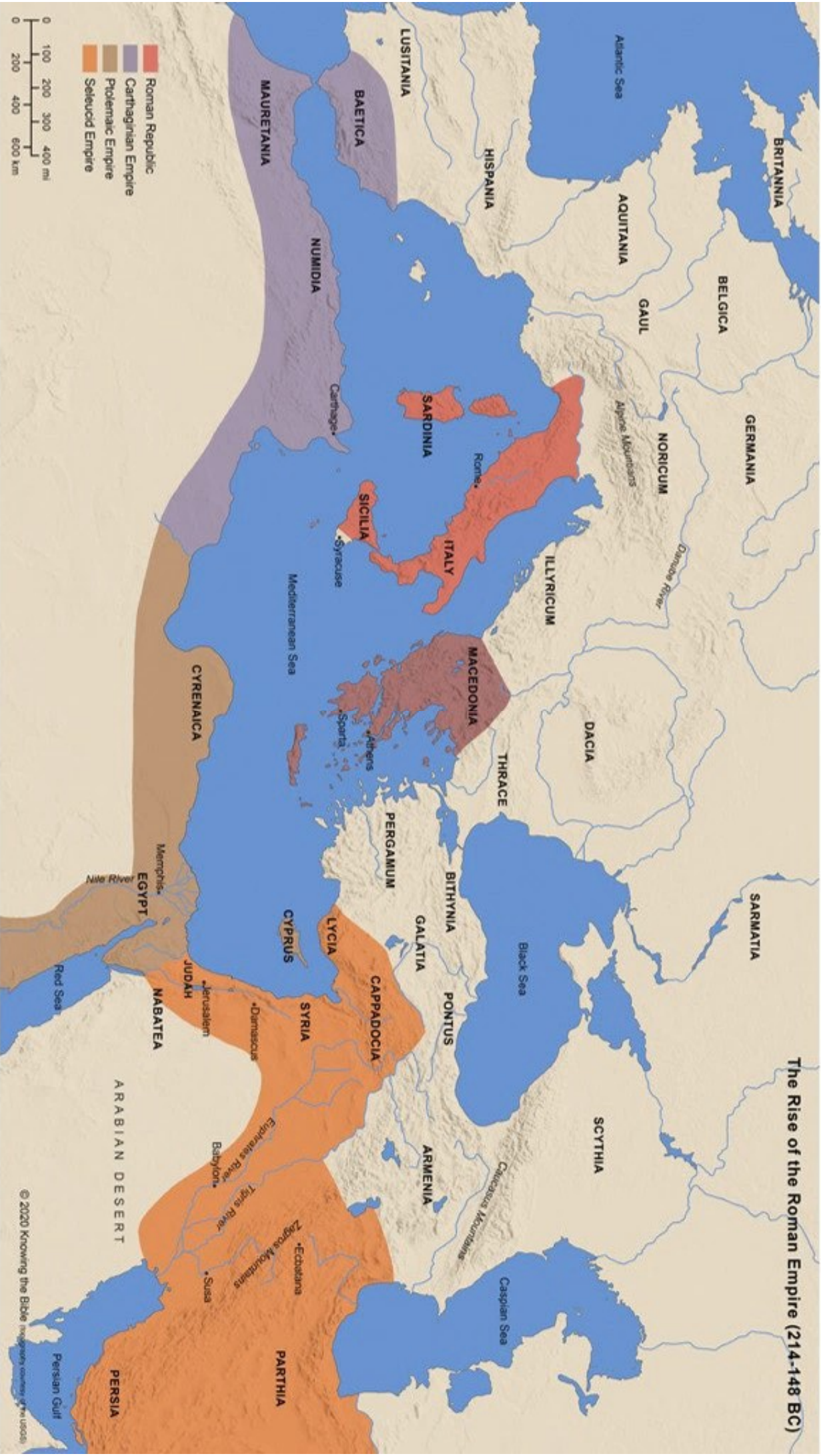

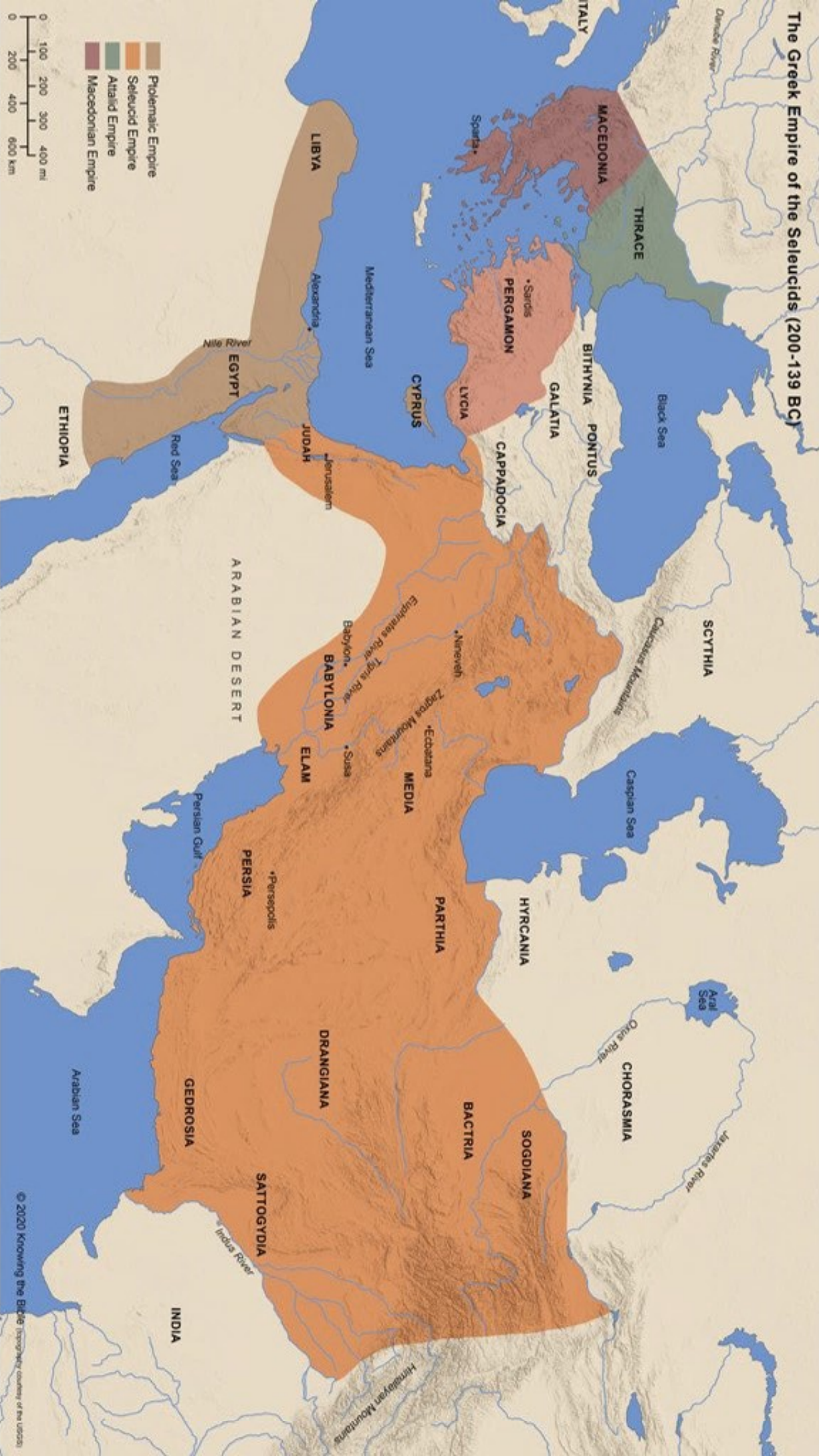
Geographical Features and Regions:

 - North Africa:** CYRENAICA, EGYPT, JUDAH, NABATEA, ARABIAN DESERT, PERSIA.
 - Asia:** SYRIA, CYPRUS, LYCIA, CAPPADOCIA, PARATHIA.
 - Islands:** SICILIA, SARDINIA, ITALY, MACEDONIA.
- Key Cities:** Rome, Carthage, Syracuse, Athens, Sparta, Jerusalem, Damascus, Babylon, Susa, Ecbatana.

Scale: 0 to 600 km (0 to 400 miles).

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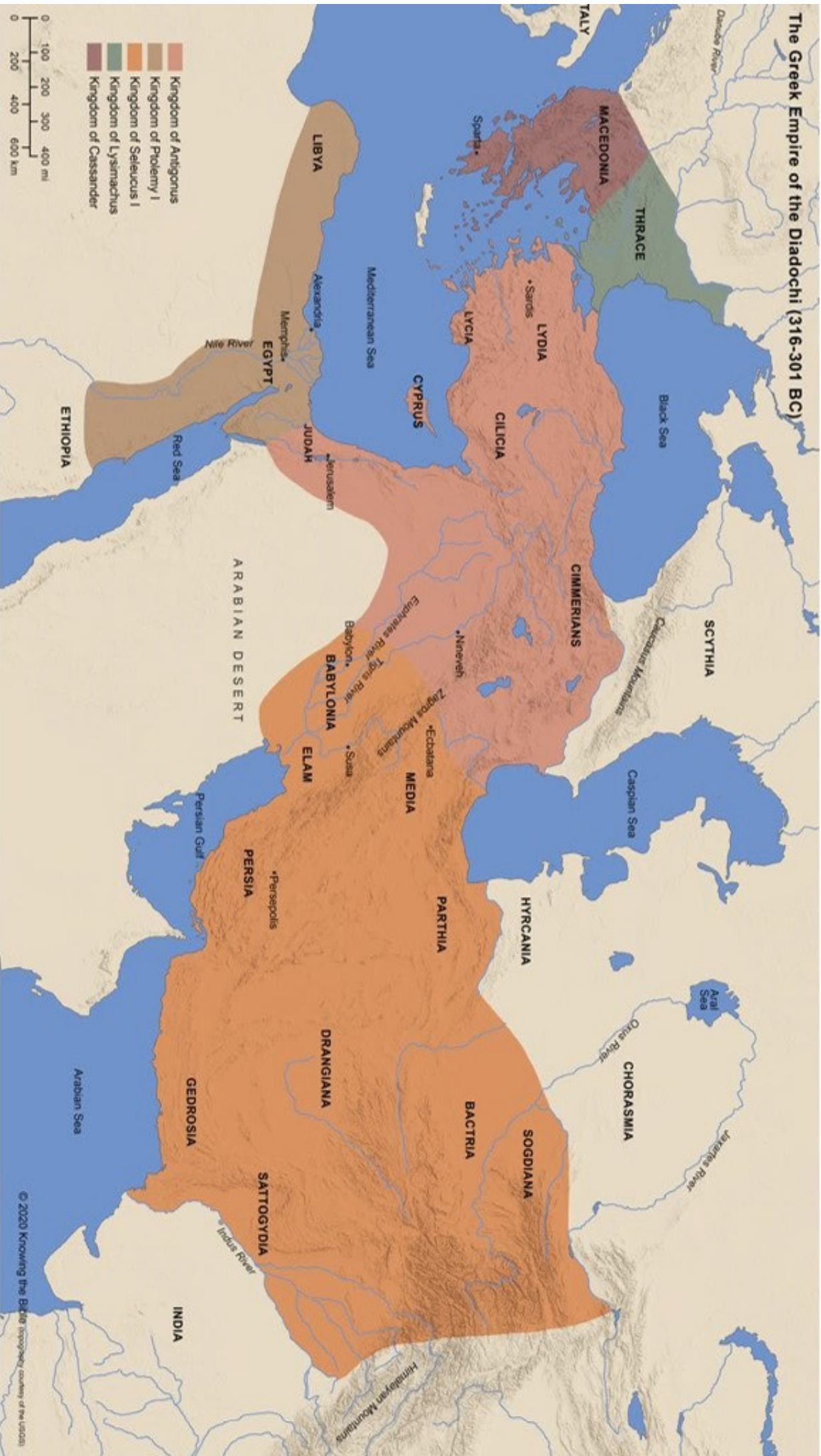


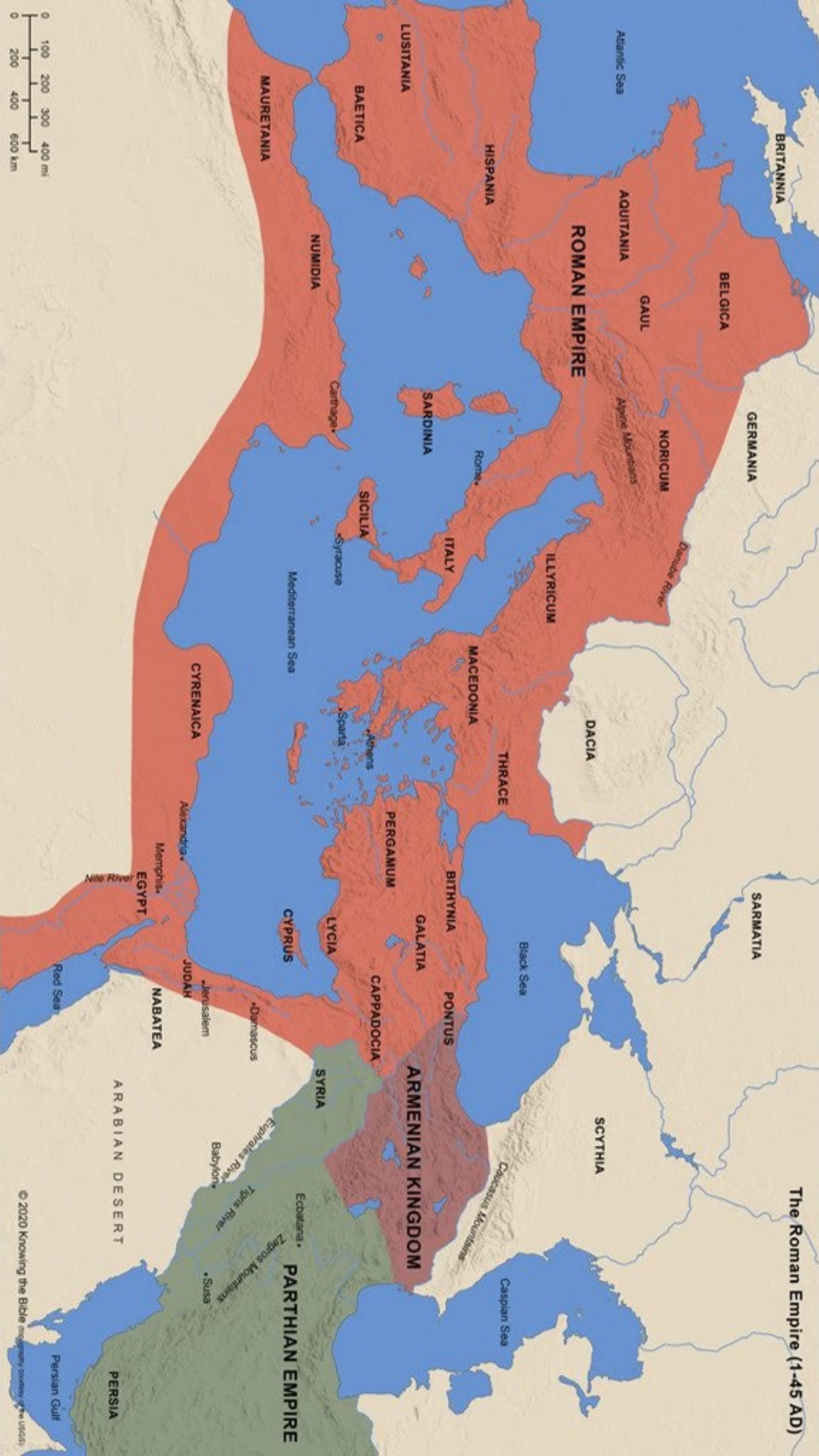


The Ancient Near East During the Patriarchs (Genesis 12-50)
